The VET@HOME project was a successful joint initiative of organizations from 5 countries - Bulgaria, Spain, Portugal, Republic of North Macedonia and Croatia.

We worked together for the last 32 months in order to offer and pilot a new approach for the distant delivery of digital practical training for the profession of "Cook".

We closed the project with the Final Partner Meeting and Project Sustainability Workshop we had in Tetovo, North Macedonia where we made an overview of all the outputs created, analyzed the development and testing of the e-learning platform and the piloting actions and planed the multiplier events in the partner countries.

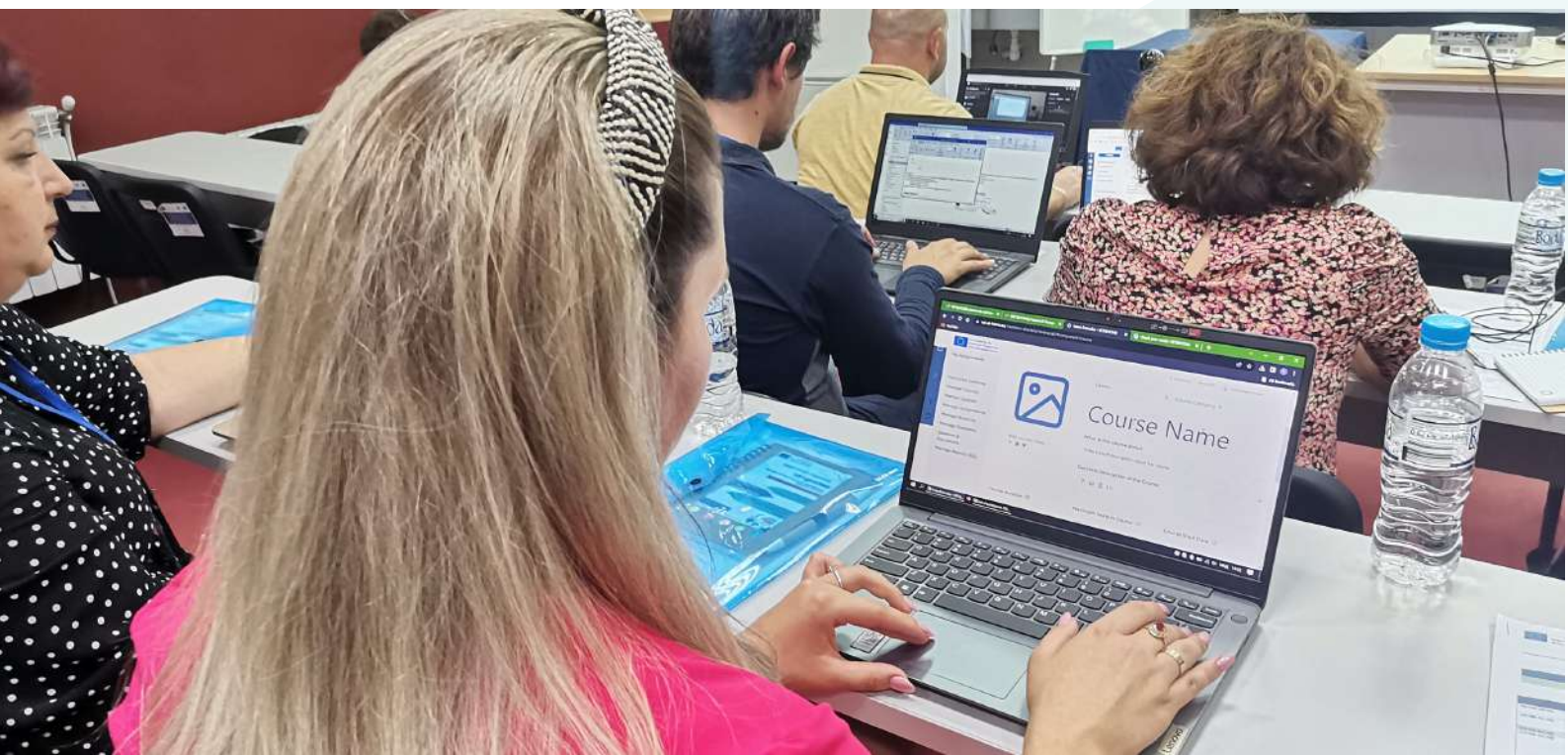

NATIONAL CONFERENCES "PRACTICAL VET IN THE DIGITAL ERA"

A series of national multipliers events were organized in all partner countries to present the project achievements. The events were organized by the partners with the aim to mobilize the project target groups and promote the project results and their further application.



The Bulgarian project results' dissemination campaign was organized by International College Ltd. in two separate events starting with a National Conference "Practical VET in the Digital Era" held on 25.10.2023 in Sofia, Bulgaria.

The project team presented the outputs developed within the VET@HOME project and then had a fruitful discussion and networking sessions with the representatives of the NAVET in Bulgaria, professional high-schools in Tourism , VET Centers and other stakeholders.

The participants shared their satisfaction with the results presented and intention to take advantage of the tools and resources provided by the VET@HOME project.

Another conference for presenting the project and its achievement was held on 31.10.2023 in Varna, Bulgaria and marked the project official closure.



The National Conference in Croatia, organized and hosted by the ASOO took place in Zagreb on 26.10.2023 with the participation of more than 30 people among which: VET teachers from VET centres and VET "high-schools", VET learners, representative of the city government from the department for education, sport and youth, etc.

The event received a great interest and after the closure of the online streaming on the project Facebook page of the plenary and presentation sessions for introducing the project results and achievement, the participants and the organizers held a fruitful discussions regarding quality assurance in distance-mode VET and the valuing of its learning outcomes. The event was closed by a networking session for generating business-VET partnerships and recommendations policy reforms.





In Tetovo, Republic of North Macedonia the National Conference organized by ZDRUZENIE INSTITUT ZA RAZVOJ NA ZAEDNICATA (CDI) raised the awareness among the interested groups and gained a great interest. In addition to the presentation of the project outputs, our partners discussed with the participants the VET in LLL - Opportunities and Limitations in the Post-pandemic period and (like in all other countries) facilitated networking sessions dedicated to the generating business-VET partnerships and recommendations for policy reforms.

Our partners at Proandi had their National “Practical VET in the Digital Era” Conference on 30.10.2023 at Povoa de Varzim, Portugal for presenting the project’s results. They talked about the syllabus and e-learning platform and promoted the distance practical courses for cook accommodated on the VET@HOME platform. In the following sessions the participants were introduced to the Protocol and Guidebook for trainers and company tutors, as well as were involved in the discussion on the possible policy reforms following the developed Roadmap for accreditation within the project. Finally, the Director Mrs. Paola Sausa encouraged the participants, and especially the young people among them, to think of the role of the practical VET through digital technologies for the disadvantaged learners and to improve the access to VET and qualifications for all.



In Spain FASE met their stakeholders in a series of 3 events organized in Zaragoza on 16, 30 and 31th of October 2023. Their efforts were aimed at communicating the policy and social relevance of the project, as well as its future beneficial impact. Although in smaller groups the participants were introduced to the project results and managed to discuss how can the VET-sector benefit from the digital technologies.



All multiplier events were life-streamed for the wider audience on the project Facebook page.

Salads



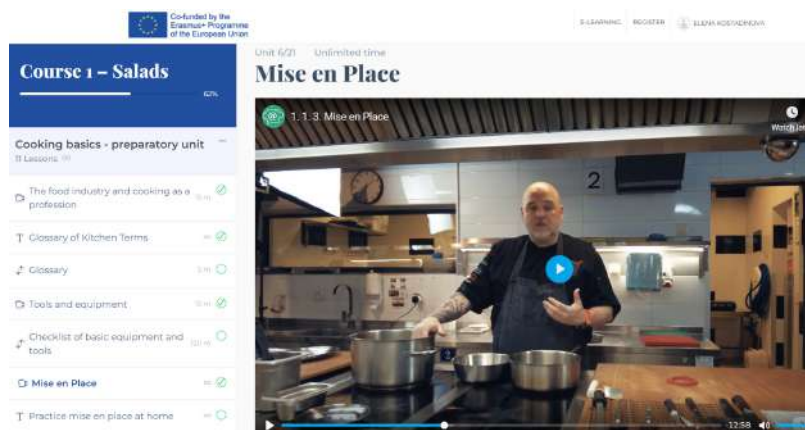
Soups
